Next week is Road safety week and so here are some reminders for parents and children:

Sober—I'll never drive after drinking any alcohol or drugs. I'll speak out if someone's about to drive on drink or drugs.

Secure— I'll make sure everyone in my vehicle is belted up on every journey. I'll choose the safest vehicle I can and ensure it's maintained.

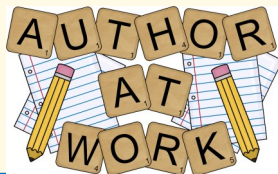

Sharp— I'll stay focussed on safe driving. I'll take regular breaks and never drive if I'm tired, stressed or on medication that affects driving. I'll get my eyes tested every two years and wear glasses or lenses at the wheel if I need them.

Sustainable—I'll minimise the amount I drive, or not drive at all. I'll get about by walking, cycling or public transport as much as I can.
