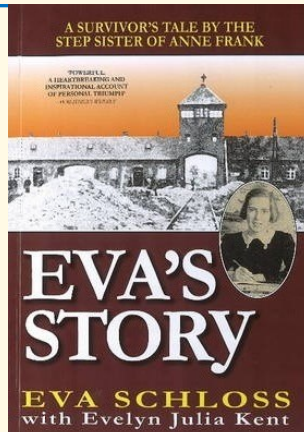


# St Anthony's Newsletter

We can't wait to see everyone at this year's Christmas Fair, tomorrow from 12-3pm.

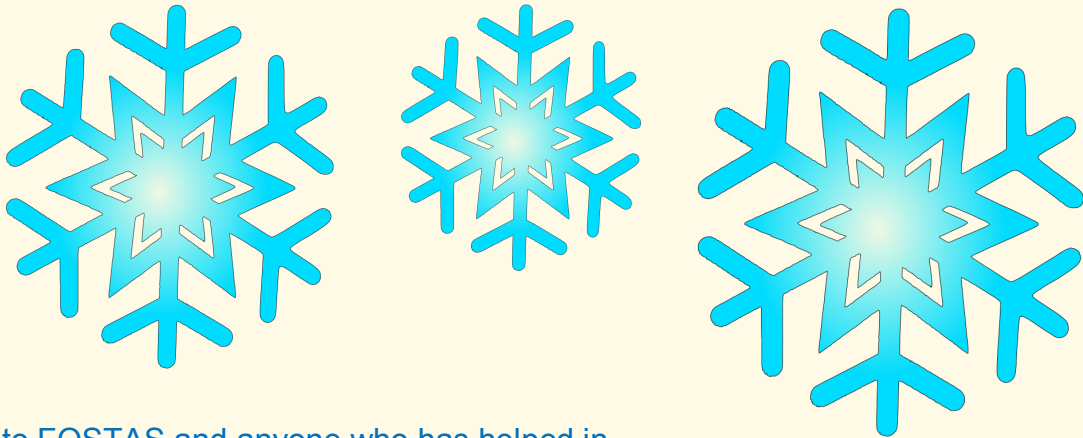
Visit Santa's Magical Grotto and the special children's-only gift shop where they can buy a gift for parents, carers, grandparents.
