Remember, punctuality is extremely important so make sure you leave home in plenty of time.

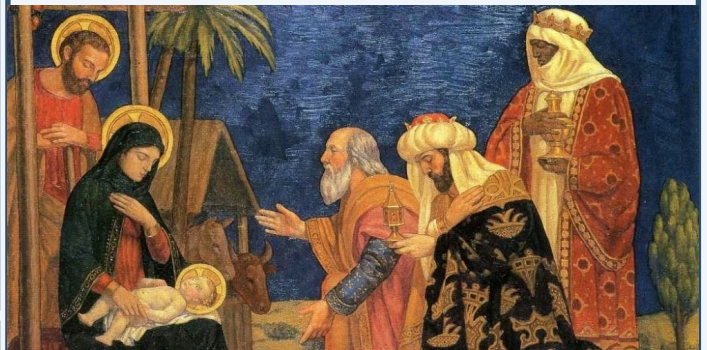
Faith Life
