Early Years

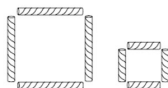
8. David and his friends shared some biscuits between the four of them. They have 3 each. How many biscuits did they start with?

You can make 2 squares from the eight straws.

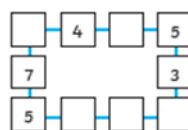


Arrange your eight straws to make 3 squares, all the same size.

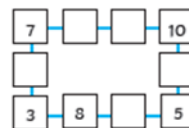
