Free WW1 exhibition

The *Remembering 1916* exhibition has a range of original artefacts from the period including extremely rare first issues of the British trench newspaper, *The Wipers Times*; British, French and German uniforms and equipment and a train station sign from the French city of Verdun. A number of carefully-created scenes provide the background for many of the items; these begin with the arrival of one man's conscription papers in an Edwardian hallway, and go on to include British and German trenches and an Edwardian drawing room, providing a snapshot of a moment in the life of an officer home on leave. The exhibition is now completely free (previously £20 family ticket) and closes on Easter Sunday. Opening times are 10am - 5pm, 7 days a week (last entry 4:00pm) Whitgift Exhibition Centre, Haling Park, South Croydon, CR2 6YT

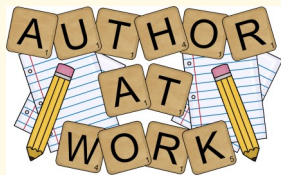
