## Athletics clubs

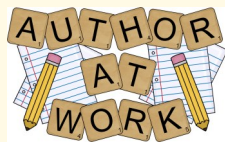

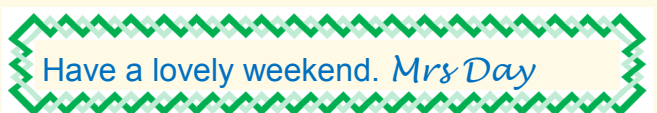
